The Thornton Board of Selectmen met and held a meeting on Wednesday, November 4, 2009, 7:00 PM at the Thornton Town Hall.

At 7:05 PM Selectmen Parziale called the meeting to order.

7:05 Police Chief Parent

Chief presented a letter from the Thornton Central School requesting a no parking zone along Route 175. The Board agreed that it is a problem and asked the Chief to draft a letter for them to review.

Motion

7:15 Selectmen Sabourn moved to enter Non-Public session under RSA 91-A: 3 II (a), Selectmen Tyler seconded. Roll call was taken. Selectmen Sabourn-yes, Selectmen Tyler-yes and Selectmen Parziale- yes. Motion passed 3-0-0.

Discussion ensued on a police department personnel issue

Motion

10:25 PM Selectmen Tyler moved to exit Non-Public session under RSA 91-A: 3 II (a), Roll call was taken. Selectmen Sabourn-yes, Selectmen Tyler-yes and Selectmen Parziale- yes. Motion passed 3-0-0.

A police personnel issue was discussed in non-public. It was further agreed by the Board and Administration that all Police employees personnel files will be kept in the Police Department with the understanding that all is available to the Selectmen and Town Administrator upon request.

Action Folder:

Hartley quote for \$28,000 for the well abandonment and to hook up the Town Hall and Fire Department to the Highway well. It was agreed that the quote was high and discussion ensued about how the Town might be able to save money on this project. It was agreed to have further discussion on this project during the budget process.

The preliminary estimate from the state in response to the State Aid Bridge application was discussed and the Board felt that the rebuild of the bridge may not be the solution. They thought replacing the bridge might be a better approach. TA Beaulieu informed the Board that Nancy Mayville and the engineers involved will meet the Board on site at the Millbrook Bridge for

further discussion 9:30 AM, November 10th. Selectmen Parziale & Sabourn will attend
Selectmen Tyler will not be able to attend due to prior commitments.

The Board asked TA Beaulieu to post the meeting and request RA Dubey to attend.

Hidden Acres Road being accepted by the Town continues to be a problem and has been
forwarded to counsel to assist in the proper procedure the town should follow for the road and
cistern.

Selectmen Tyler shared that Marian Fillion called and asked if there was anywhere in town that
they could place a clothing box. It was agreed by all that the only place would be the transfer
station and another company already has a box in place.

Jim Demeritt expressed a concern on an area on Millbrook Road by the apple tree that will need
the highway crew to establish a ditch line before winter or they will have major problems.

Walter Joyce was concerned about the public access to salt/sand pile this winter. Board asked TA
Beaulieu to call Granite State to discuss their memo informing the town that the salt sold to the
town is for the town roads and not for any other use.
