#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

## > Review Campton CIP

- It appears that the Thornton CIP and the Campton CIP have fallen out of sync with capital purchases to be made for the Transfer Station and the Fire Department. The 2 plans were in sync prior to changes made by the Thornton BOS for the Thornton CIP dated 2022 – 2031.
- Purchase year changes in the Thornton CIP have impacted Fire Engine # 2 (moved from 2021 to 2022). Fire Engine #4 (moved from 2023 to 2024). Ambulance #2 (moved from 2024 to 2021). The Ambulance #2 change will alter the beginning balance of the Fire Capital Reserve balance for the 2022-2031 plan.
- At this time Campton has not added 2031 into their plan and there is a purchase of a Trash Hopper and Ram (cost to be split) between the 2 towns. The committee discussed the issues and will make their recommendations to the BOS at the next scheduled meeting between the two.

# Discuss future meeting with Thornton BOS and Campton CIP inputs

- The committee will continue to finalize the plan and communicate the issues with Thornton and Campton. There is a scheduled joint budget meeting for both towns on December 13, 2021.
- Joe Monti suggested to Al Lewis that it would be helpful to develop a sheet comparing the changes for the meeting with the Thornton BOS.

### **NEW BUSINESS (continued):**

### > Review Thornton Draft CIP

- Discussed the Transfer Station (TS) paving needs (paving funded in 2021 plan, but TS not paved) and future related site work for a scale system to weigh incoming construction vehicles and the debris they carry in for disposal.
- Discussed adding \$100,000 to the Millbrook Capital Reserve Fund. Need to evaluate the scope of the work to control costs, while at the same time satisfactorily upgrading the condition of the road.
