  survey. Myrtle will send her information (including an interpretation from the NHACC
  on what conservation funds can be used for). The TCC also plans to communicate
  with the BOS about these matters. Myrtle also asked Desiree about the "recreational
  immunity" legal interpretation.

#### 3. Riverfront Property Presentation By DES

- Myrtle Lewis has a Zoom meeting on March 21 with two Department of Environmental Services (DES) employees. The Riverfront Property presentation is scheduled for Friday, June 9<sup>th</sup> from 2:00 – 3:00 PM.
