The Thornton Police Department is currently accepting applications for an anticipated Full-Time Patrol Officer vacancy.

The current 2024 pay scale for patrol ranges from \$27.42-\$37.83 depending on experience.

Officers enjoy a relaxed but professional uniform standard which allows well-groomed facial hair, visible tattoos, and exterior vests.

Officers are also issued a cruiser (restrictions apply) and a patrol rifle. The police department also recently updated their pistols, Taser, and Body Camera programs.

Officers also receive a gym membership to a local gym that is open 24 hours.

Officers work a rotating 4 on 3 off schedule with rotating weekends off and the ability to swap shifts as needed.

The Town of Thornton offers a top-tier medical plan with 85% of the premium paid for by the town. Those who have insurance elsewhere are eligible to receive a yearly \$5000.00 stipend.

The Town of Thornton also provides 12 paid holidays, personal days, 2 weeks of paid vacation after the 1st year of continuous employment (non-certified officers), and sick time.

Applicants must be 21 years of age and possess a high school diploma or GED. Applicants will be required to pass a physical agility test as set forth by NH Police Standard and Training, Oral Board interview, Chief's Interview, Polygraph examination, drug screen, and rigorous background investigation.
