Town of Thornton Transfer Station Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes January 28, 2021 @6:00 PM

- The meeting was conducted at the Thornton Town Hall on January 12, 2021 from 6:00 PM until 8:08 PM. Members were socially distanced in the room and wore masks.
- The meeting was also accessible via Zoom and several people called in.
- Participating in the meeting were: Steve Chiocca, Peter Laufenberg, Dan Boynton, Julie Piehn, Candy Andrews, Myrtle Lewis, Bob McCabe, Bill DeLeo, and Roy Sabourn.
- Peter Laufenberg (Chair) started the meeting and the following items were discussed:
 - The last TSAC meeting (January 14, 2021) minutes were approved by the Committee.
 - Most of the meeting was spent discussing specific changes to the draft Transfer Station Ordinance, including:
 - Adding several definitions including: business user, home occupations, short-term rental, long-term rental, contractor, etc.
 - Temporary permit for contractor's job will last 30 days
 - Construction projects must show proof of the construction project address
 - Commercial trash haulers must comply with recycling requirements and must dispose of weekdays only
 - Need a town dumpster policy for restaurants, stores, etc. (Myrtle, Bill & Roy will work on this); this would apply for Thornton-Campton-Ellsworth
 - Do not allow the use of black trash bags after January 1, 2022 (and at discretion of TS Manager)
 - Need to develop a communication plan for rolling out clear bags (at Campton Cupboard, Handyman Hardware, Hannaford's, etc.)
 - There have been no big issues or complaints, associated with the Sunday closures
 - We need a form of transferrable permits for "shared" homes; Steve was very opposed to it (we can implement it and if it doesn't work, we can change it (ultimately, it is at the discretion of the BOS
 - There were many changes to the draft TSAC Ordinance which Bill noted and he will issue the draft ordinance revision # 5, for review
 - Need to improve signage for navigating through the TS, "well signed"
 - Peter will work on the Executive Summary, which he will present to the BOS
