Sobolewski 58 **Discussion: None** 59 Roll Call Vote: 4-YES, 0-NO, 0-ABSTAIN 60 Motion passes. 61 62 Remanded Application to the Planning Board 63 O September 7, 2021 Planning Board Meeting minutes 64 Mr. Monti acknowledged Mr. Babin, Mr. Laufenberg, and Ms. Decoteau as members of the Planning 65 Board in attendance. 66 67 Mr. Monti clarified that several members of the ZBA were unhappy with comments made by members of 68 the Planning Board in the meeting minutes of September 7, 2021. Mr. Monti asked the ZBA members for 69 their thoughts on the minutes. 70 71 Ms. Marshall stated she does not see any value in further discussing the comments made; the members of 72 the Planning Board are welcome to state their own opinions, as are the members of the ZBA. Ms. 73 Marshall stated both Boards did their due diligence in coming to their respective decisions regarding the 74 Vertex Tower Assets, LLC project. 75 76 Mr. Sobolewski stated the ZBA worked very hard on the issues and concerns of the residents regarding 77 the tower. He sated the comments in the Planning Board minutes indicating that the ZBA does not have 78 the Town's best interests in mind are entirely false, and that reading those comments hit him and the other 79 ZBA members hard. 80 81 Mr. Monti stated the original plan submitted by Vertex had the driveway access coming off of Treeline Road, and the ZBA made them change the location of the road based on what the residents wanted. He 82 83 stated there is a gap in cellular coverage that needs to be filled, and the location of the tower in a residential zone was the only solution available. Mr. Monti wanted to make clear that the ZBA and 84 85 Planning Board both take all matters brought to them seriously, and think their decisions through; they do not act cavalierly, as legal and expert counsel and opinion are taken into account. 86 87 88 Mr. Babin agreed with everything the Board said and stated that both Boards had the best interests of 89 residents in mind when rendering their decisions. He stated the ZBA did everything within the confines 90 of the law but feels that non-residents interpreting the Town Ordinances leaves room for error. 91 92 Mr. Babin stated the Planning Board is currently working on amending the Zoning Ordinance, including 93 the Telecommunications Facility Ordinance. He stated he does not agree with how the process of the 94 Tower proceeded, but landowners have a right to do what they want on their land within the Ordinances. 95 96 Mr. Babin stated comments made in the Planning Board meeting minutes were not intended to offend, 97 and he apologized if any one was offended. Mr. Babin stated there was perception of the Boards being at

odds with one another, but that was never the case; both Chairs acted admirably. Mr. Babin thanked the

99 ZBA for all their work, and the Planning Board will let the ZBA know when the next work session for the Zoning Ordinance Amendments is to get feedback. 100 101 102 Mr. Laufenberg stated he wanted to offer an apology to the ZBA if his opinions expressed in the Planning 103 Board minutes caused offense. He stated the ZBA put a lot of work into their decision, and he didn't 104 want to come across as if he was attacking the Board's character. 105 106 Ms. Decoteau stated her reason for abstaining from the vote on the Vertex Tower reads differently than it 107 was intended. She stated when the Planning Board received the remanded application, it felt like a 108 decision had already been made and there was nothing left to decide. Ms. Decoteau stated she was 109 frustrated with the process as a whole and felt like the ZBA got to make the final decision. She stated by no means did she intend for her comments to indicate that the ZBA did not do their best to make a well-110 111 informed decision. 112 113 The ZBA members thanked Mr. Babin, Mr. Laufenberg, and Ms. Decoteau for their comments this 114 evening.
